- Hard Insurance Markets Prevail
- Insurance tender over summer months
- Allianz most competitive 3 year partnership LTA
- Stability in cost of insurance over next 3 years
- Profit share agreement based on future claims record
- Risk Management Services surveys every 3 years
- Catastrophe Losses exposure limited to €80k per claim
- Comprehensive policy covers provides peace of mind

EDUCENA – BOM Duty of Care - Trustees

Property Management

- BOM's as Licensees have a duty of care to Property Owners & Trustees
- Health & Safety Compliance providing a safe place for Education
- Formalise use of facilities by written Licence Agreements with local clubs
- Prompt reporting of accidents & potential claims to Allianz
- Identifying hazards and taking action to remove same
- Vetting of credentials of contractors before engagement on building works

EDUCENA – Approval Requirements - BOM

Required for


- Planning applications extensions or change in use
- Building or structural changes
- Changes that affects boundaries
- Change in Rights of Way
- Sub-letting (new or renewal) or grant of licences to third parties
- Bank pledges or liens

CEIST Schools Energy Supply Contracts

- 50% of CEIST Schools signed up to NGP tender offer in Oct'15
- Energia current supplier NGP contracts for renewal 1st Nov'17
- Outlook is for energy prices to increase
- Recommending CEIST Schools to participate in NGP new contract
- OGP programme runs to 30th April, 2018
- Out of Contract Exposed to higher prices & future increases
- Best to fix rates now and stabilise energy costs for 24 to 36 months

Market Trend Gas Prices


NBP Y 1 GBp/therm GBp/therm

- CEIST Schools out of contract are paying 10% higher (based on current Price).

Oil Price Forecast

- Oil Market is set to continue its recovery and will put upward pressure on Gas prices
- Growing demand on the Energy Grid will increase demand on Gas and will increase rates

- Sub-Lettings should be formalised by Licence and approved by EDUCENA
- Substantial insurance building claims must be notified to CEIST & EDUCENA
- Energy Contract Renewal 31st October next Consent forms required
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
