In the middle of the eighteenth century Nano Nagle set up schools to provide a Catholic education for the poor of Cork city, a dangerous and courageous undertaking during the time of the Penal Laws. Twenty years later, in 1775, she founded a religious congregation, known today as the Presentation Sisters.

The film of her life will be called Nano Nagle, Lady of the Lantern.
