APPLICATION OPENS: 20th April 2020
DEADLINE TO APPLY: 15th May 2020

We offer grants to assist schools to integrate Global Citizenship Education (GCE) into their school community.

How much can our school apply for?

Starter School Grant – Up to €600
for schools that are relatively new to GCE and/or new to engaging with WWGS.

Established School Grant – Up to €1,200
For schools that are experienced in GCE and have previously engaged with WWGS.

What can you use the grant for?

- Teacher planning time
- Student action projects
- Whole school events on Global Justice themes
- Trips and in-school workshops on Global Justice themes

What is Global Citizenship Education?

Global Citizenship Education enables students to acquire the knowledge, skills, attitudes and values necessary to become global citizens who take action to transform the world.
